

## Ventana Ranch Community Association Swimming Pool Usage Policy SUMMER 2011

Hours of Operation: 11:00 AM through 8:30 PM Monday-Friday  
10:00 AM through 8:30 PM Saturday  
12:00 PM through 6:00 PM Sunday

Pool will open every day from Saturday, May 28th (Memorial Day Weekend), through Sunday, August 21st, and weekends only until Labor Day weekend, Monday, September 5th, weather permitting.

### User Fees:

1. In order to keep the Ventana Ranch Homeowners Association dues to a minimum, User Fees will be charged for using the swimming pool. There are no user fees for the tennis court.
2. Adults will be charged \$2.25 per day. Seniors 65 and older will be charged \$1.00 and children ages 6-17 (must show photo ID displaying birth date) will be charged \$1.50 per day. Children 5 and younger are free.
3. Summer membership rates are as follows:  
Family of four (or more): \$110  
Family of three: \$100  
Couple: \$70 Non –Senior /\$50 Seniors  
Single: \$60 Non-Senior /\$40 Seniors

\*A pass will be issued, and must be presented to gain access to the pool area.

4. Guests: Guest fees are the same as fees for residents. GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A VENTANA RANCH RESIDENT.

## **Swimming Pool Rules- General Rules:**

1. The Pool Manager and Lifeguards are empowered to enforce all rules. Please remember that they enforce the rules, they do not make them. These rules are for your safety and for the safety of those around you.
2. Violation of pool rules will be grounds for pool privileges to be revoked or suspended.
3. The cost of property damage due to negligence or abuse will be charged to the responsible homeowner.
4. The pool is only for use by Ventana Ranch residents and their guests. Due to insurance regulations, access will not be granted to those not appearing on the association roster or those that cannot provide proof that they live within Ventana Ranch. A current association roster will be maintained at the pool. The Facilities Manager and Lifeguards have been instructed to check the membership roster in order to ensure that unauthorized persons are not allowed access.
5. Anyone entering the pool area must register themselves and their guest (s) and fill out the appropriate forms.
6. The City of Albuquerque Health Department REQUIRES that before entering the pool, you MUST take a shower.
7. Only members whose accounts are current will be allowed to use the pool and recreation facility.
8. Please be courteous and dispose of trash in the proper receptacles.
9. Children under 12 years of age must be attended by an adult 18 years of age or older.
10. No bicycles, roller blades, scooters, or skateboards, in the pool area.
11. No glass containers in the pool area.
12. NO DIVING
13. No running in the pool area
14. Bathing suits are the only attire permitted in pool. Individuals wearing shorts, cutoff jeans, pants or similar articles of clothing will not be allowed to enter the pool.
15. No food or drinks allowed in the pool.
16. No pets allowed in the pool area, except service animals.
17. Volume on radios must be kept low or earphones used.

18. Swim diapers must be worn by children, as necessary.
19. No alcohol in the pool area, anyone showing signs of intoxication will be asked to vacate the premises.
20. No smoking in pool area.
21. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
22. Admission may be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections or if wearing bandages. Band-Aids cannot be worn in the pool.
23. Unaccompanied guest are not allowed in the pool or pool area. A Ventana Ranch resident must accompany all guests.
24. Members and guests are not to engage in conversation with on-duty Lifeguards.
25. The wading pool is to be used by children four years of age and younger, and only when accompanied by a responsible sitter or adult.
26. Flotation devices are allowed only at the discretion of the lifeguards or Facilities Manager.
27. Kickboards may be used for lap swimming and instruction use only.
28. No balls are allowed in pool or pool area.
29. All beverages must be consumed in an area more than ten feet from the edge of the pools. Trash must be placed in the proper receptacle before leaving the pool area.
30. Pool furniture and accessories must be kept in their designated areas. Furniture in the wading pool area must remain on the deck.
31. Horseplay (i.e. flipping or throwing children, diving, standing on shoulders, chicken fights, dunking, etc.) or any other unsafe or dangerous activities, in the judgment of the Pool Staff, may result in disciplinary action.
32. Fighting or abusive language is not allowed. Violators will be removed from the pool area at the discretion of the Pool Staff.
33. Please refrain from leaning or hanging on the lap lane floats.
34. Super soakers or other squirting devices are not allowed within the pool area.
